Youth Ministry Vision and Organization of Parent's Youth Ministry Team

Thanks so much for the large turnout of parents of youth after church Sunday. As I recall we decided to meet for lunch at the church after worship on Sunday Feb. 26. If Jon Krispin can be there he will give us the scoop on Young Life Valdosta. As I mentioned be ready with input: - Things we have done well and want to continue- Things we may want to add I'd like us to think strategically about things we want our youth to have firmly in heart and mind after they have been through our youth program. Some things to think about - The youth version of the Truth Project, a primer in world view and apologetics - Biblical knowledge, overview and firm grasp of the covenant that ties Old and New Testament together- Strategies for moral purity and resistance of negative peer pressure- Fully disciple in personal spiritual disciplines- Exposure to the wider Christian community through involvement in things like Young Life, mission/service projects etching have already been asked about the feasibility of finding a part-time youth pastor. This will require a commitment to funding above our present budgetary demands so gird up your loins and count the cost. Looking forward to building a team of parents that will be actively supporting our youth. Think about rotating youth home groups among parents, intergenerational mission trips with parents participating, etc. ~Ken
